









- Tier 5 members cannot retire with their full pension until age 65, regardless of the number of years they have worked.
- Anyone hired after May 21, 2010, must work 32 hours a week to be enrolled in the pension—this impacts many of our ESP members. These members are in DCRP and will not qualify for post-retirement medical benefits.
- You have never missed a pension payment, but the state failed to pay their share for decades.

Under the Murphy administration, a fourth full pension payment will be made this school year.
