

Buy a brick & support NJEA's Hipp Foundation



When NJEA's new headquarters building was completed in 2002, the **NJEA Frederick L. Hipp Foundation for Excellence in Education** launched the Pathway to Excellence Campaign. The pathway leads visitors to the building's main entrance. The campaign allows members, affiliates, and other friends of education to contribute to the foundation by purchasing a permanently engraved brick in the walkway.

Single engraved brick pavers, measuring four by eight inches, are available at the introductory contribution level of \$100 each, with progressive contribution levels for closer proximity to the entrance and larger engraved pavers.

Bricks have been purchased in the name of local and county associations. Members have purchased bricks on the occasion of the retirement of a beloved colleague.

Some have simply purchased bricks for no special reason other than to show their support for the Hipp Foundation.

What is the Hipp Foundation?


NJEA's Frederick L. Hipp Foundation for Excellence in Education was established in 1993.

Named for the late Dr. Frederick L. Hipp, who served as NJEA's executive director for 32 years, the Hipp Foundation awards annual grants for innovative education programs that would not otherwise be funded within the local school district budget. The Foundation has awarded nearly \$2 million dollars in grants since its inception.
